

## **RULE SYNOPSIS**

### Draft rule language for Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapter 3745-80 “Statewide Motor Vehicle Anti-tampering Program”

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control has reviewed OAC Chapter 3745-80 “Statewide Motor Vehicle Anti-tampering Program” pursuant to Ohio law (Ohio Revised Code Section 119.032) which requires all agencies review existing rules every five years to determine if the rules should be eliminated or amended, or to remain “as-is.”

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the Division formally adopts them. On July 1, 2015 these rules went out for a 30-day review by interested parties. Ohio EPA received no comments on these rules.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the rules in this chapter and determined that changes are needed. The changes are as follows:

#### **OAC rule 3745-80-01 Definitions**

DAPC is suggesting a limited number of changes to this rule as presented below in descending order (paragraph (K) through paragraph (M)).

- Paragraph (K) defines the term, “tamper with.” A minor grammatical change was made.
- Paragraph (M) includes references to certain subject matter or materials. Minor language and grammatical changes were made. Reference material information and availability was updated.

#### **OAC rule 3745-80-02 Tampering prohibitions**

- Small typographic and grammatical changes

#### **OAC rule 3745-80-03 Anti-tampering inspection procedures and requirements**

- The rule contains language describing how anti-tampering inspections shall be performed in accordance to U.S. EPA requirements. Minor grammatical changes were made.
