


*Technical assistance is available during the post CNS compliance process when the property is anticipated to be out of compliance (or compliance is unknown) with applicable standards. Additionally, technical assistance may be requested after the property is voluntarily brought back into compliance without Agency prior knowledge and the volunteer seeks Agency concurrence.

**If Ohio EPA discovers such non-compliance, ORC 3746.12(B)(2) and (3), in summary, require that the entity responsible for compliance with applicable standards notify the Director of his intention to return the property to compliance with applicable standards and enter into a compliance schedule agreement with the Director. If the entity fails to take the aforementioned steps, the Director is required to revoke the CNS pursuant to ORC 3746.12(B)(3).


Post CNS Cure Process



***ORC 3746.12(B)(3) requires the recipient of a NONC respond to the Director within 30 days of mailing of the NONC. The response is required to include a statement of the NONC recipient's intention to return the property or portion thereof to compliance with applicable standards upon which the issuance of the covenant was based and also requires the recipient to enter into a compliance schedule agreement with the Director. If the recipient fails to respond in accordance with the requirements of ORC 3746.12(B)(3), the Director is required to revoke the CNS.


Agency Verification and Notification Mechanisms for compliance with applicable standards
