Tracking universal waste shipments- standards for destination facilities.

- (A) The owner or operator of a destination facility shall keep a record of each shipment of universal waste received at the facility. The record may take the form of a log, invoice, manifest, bill of lading, or other shipping document. The record for each shipment of universal waste received shall include the following information:
- (1) The name and address of the universal waste handler, destination facility, or foreign shipper from whom the universal waste was sent;
 - (2) The quantity of each type of universal waste received (e.g., batteries, pesticides, thermostats);
 - (3) The date of receipt of the shipment of universal waste.
- (B) The owner or operator of a destination facility shall retain the records described in paragraph (A) of this rule for at least three years from the date of receipt of a shipment of universal waste.
