Dear Mr. Darr:

On June 20, 2007, Ohio EPA received Premcor Refining Group, Inc.'s (Premcor) request to reduce the frequency of post-closure inspections of Primary and "C" Ponds from weekly to quarterly. For this modification, Premcor submitted a Class 2 modification application¹. The Agency did not receive any verbal or written comments concerning this Class 2 modification application. I have enclosed the final modified Ohio hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) that was issued by the director today. Please note that the modified Permit remains in effect until it is renewed, withdrawn, suspended or revoked.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:



OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT

On September 21, 2007, Ohio EPA issued a final Class 2 modified Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) to Premcor Refining Group, Inc. for its facility at 1150 South Metcalf Street, Lima, Ohio 45804-1199. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD005051826.

Why is Premcor Refining Group, Inc. modifying its Permit?

Premcor Refining Group, Inc. (Premcor) currently holds a hazardous waste installation and operation permit to address closure, post-closure and corrective action activities at the facility. Premcor wishes to reduce the frequency of post-closure inspections of Primary and "C" Ponds from weekly to quarterly. This final modified permit will allow Premcor to make the requested changes. To issue this final modified Permit, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

Can I appeal this final modified Permit?

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this modified Permit, you have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

If I decide to appeal this final modified Permit, how and when must I make the appeal?

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than October 24, 2007. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. You must file your appeal, according to Ohio Revised Code § 3745.04 with ERAC at the following address: ***Environmental Review Appeals Commission***, 309 South Fourth Street, Room 222, Columbus, Ohio 43215. You must send a copy of the appeal to the director of Ohio EPA at the following address no later than three (3) days after you file it with ERAC: ***Chris Korleski, Director of Ohio EPA***, P.O. 

Class 2 Modification:

- 1) BP Products North America, Inc. and Premcor Refining Group have completed closure of the Primary and "C" Ponds. Weekly inspections of the closed areas have revealed little or no need for maintenance. Therefore, this modification will allow BP Products North America, Inc. and Premcor Refining Group to reduce the frequency of post-closure inspections of Primary and "C" Ponds from weekly to quarterly.
