Dear Mr. Darr:

On July 19, 2007, Ohio EPA received a request for a Class 1A (Class 1 requiring prior approval) hazardous waste permit modification (tracking number 070719-1A-1) from BP Products North America, Inc., and Lima Refining Company requesting to extend the expiration date of the BP Products North America / Premcor Refining Group, Inc., permit from June 20, 2008, to June 20, 2013.

As the modification referenced above is not explicitly listed in the Appendix to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-50-51, Ohio EPA has evaluated the classification of the modification application pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-50-51(E). BP Products North America, Inc and Lima Refining Company are hereby notified that Ohio EPA concurs with the classification as a Class 1A prior approval permit modification. In addition, with this letter, Ohio EPA approves the above referenced Class 1A modification, submitted pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-50-51.

The following modification has been made to your June 20, 2003, Ohio Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit. Also, the records of Ohio EPA have been changed accordingly:

- The Permit Expiration Date has been changed from June 20, 2008, to June 20, 2013.

A.3. Permit Effective/Expiration Date
OAC Rule 3745-50-54

The effective date of this permit is the date the permit is entered into the Director's Journal. The permit expiration date is June 20, 2013.

A.4. Severability

The provisions of this permit are severable, and if any provision of this permit, or the application of any provision of this permit to any circumstance, is held invalid, the application of such provision to other circumstances, and the remainder of this permit, shall not be affected thereby.

A.5. Duty to Comply
OAC Rule 3745-50-58(A)

The Permittee shall comply with all applicable provisions of ORC Chapter 3734, all applicable Ohio hazardous waste rules, and all terms and conditions of this permit, except to the extent and for the duration such noncompliance is authorized by the laws of the State of Ohio. Any permit noncompliance, other than noncompliance authorized by the laws of the State of Ohio, constitutes a violation of ORC Chapter 3734 and the rules adopted thereunder and is grounds for enforcement action, suspension, revocation, modification, revision, denial of a permit renewal application or other appropriate action.

A.6. Duty to Reapply and Permit Expiration
