



Early Stakeholder Outreach — Hazardous Waste Rules for Five-Year Review

Ohio EPA prepares early stakeholder outreach fact sheets to ensure stakeholders are brought into the review process as early as possible and to obtain additional input and discussion before development of draft rules.

What do these rules cover?

The rules addressed by this Early Stakeholder Outreach (ESO) are in the Hazardous Waste Management program, and they regulate all facets of the program including permitting; fees; identification and listing of hazardous waste; transporter standards; generator standards; treatment, storage, and disposal standards; land disposal restrictions; universal waste management; and used oil management. These rules are in the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Chapters 3745-50 to 3745-69, 3745-205, 3745-256, 3745-266, 3745-270, 3745-273, and 3745-279.

There are 92 hazardous waste rules under consideration in this ESO. They are listed in the table at the end of this document.

Why are these rules being sent out for Early Stakeholder Outreach?

The first step in the rule-making process is for Ohio EPA to identify that a rule needs to be amended, rescinded, or created. In response to Executive Order 2011-01K, Ohio EPA added a step to the rulemaking process ensure stakeholders are brought into the process as early as possible. This additional notification and request for information allows for early feedback before the rule language is developed by Ohio EPA.

The rules listed in this ESO are required to be reviewed every five years under ORC 119.032 to determine whether they should continue without change, be rescinded, or be amended. The determination as to which action will be taken for any given rule has not yet been made, but at this time we do not anticipate the rescission of any of these rules. These rules' required 5-year review date is approaching, so we are requesting your input.

Additional rules not specifically listed here may be amended if stakeholder comments on these rules indicate the need to do so.

How can I provide input?

The Agency is seeking stakeholder input on these rules. When preparing your comments, be sure to:

- explain your views as clearly as possible;
- describe any assumptions used;
- provide any technical information and/or data used to support your views;
- explain how you arrived at your estimate for potential burdens, benefits or costs;
- provide specific examples to illustrate your views; and
- offer alternatives.

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What changes are being considered?

Ohio EPA has not identified any major problems with these rules, but minor corrections to spelling, punctuation, word choice, outline structure, rule cross-references, etc. are under consideration. We anticipate that some of these rules will be continued without amendment.

Who will be regulated by these rules?

Anyone currently regulated by the hazardous waste management rules is regulated by the rules in this ESO.

What is the rulemaking schedule?

These rules will be subject to this ESO review for approximately 30 days, when comments will be due. We will consider all the comments we receive, and we will prepare a package of draft rules to be reviewed by Interested Parties, most likely in Autumn 2014.

What input is Ohio EPA seeking?

The following questions may help guide you as you develop your comments.

- Is the general regulatory framework proposed the most appropriate? Should Ohio EPA consider any alternative framework?
- What options are available for improving an identified concept?
- Are there considerations Ohio EPA should take into account when developing a specific concept?
- Is there any information or data Ohio EPA should be aware of when developing program concepts or rule language?

Ohio EPA would especially like to hear information regarding the following from stakeholders who may be impacted by the new program.

- Would this regulatory program have a positive impact on your business? Please explain how.
- Would this regulatory program have an adverse impact on your business? If so, please identify the nature of the adverse impact (for example, license fees, fines, employer time for compliance).
