Dear Mr. Bressan:

OF September 14, 2001, the Southeast District Office (SEDO) of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received a request from Globe Metallurgical, Inc. (Globe), proposing an alternative sampling and analysis frequency for ground water monitoring at the Globe Metallurgical Landfill (Facility). This request was submitted in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(6).


Globe proposes reducing the ground water sampling frequency from two events to one event per year, which is the minimum frequency provided under OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(6). Section 9.3 of the approved Closure and Post-Closure Plan for the Globe Metallurgical Landfill specifies surface water sampling frequency shall be the same as the frequency for ground water sampling. However, Globe must continue to comply with their current NPDES permit.

The request was reviewed by the Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) and the Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM). Upon review, the data submitted adequately supports the Facility's request for an alternative sampling frequency.

Therefore the sampling frequency for ground water monitoring is hereby reduced to one annual event, to occur in the spring of each year. The surface water sampling frequency must comply with the NPDES permit.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3745.04.
