Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c) Approval**

Dear Mr. Butler:

By correspondence from May 1, 2002, the owner/operator of the Rumpke Sanitary Landfill reported a statistically significant increase in the sodium concentration in ground water monitoring well MW-6S.

A ground water demonstration dated May 1, 2002, was submitted to Ohio EPA noting the principal cause of the increase of sodium in MW-6S. The demonstration concluded that the exceedance is attributed to natural variation in ground water and not a result of leachate impact. Upon review of the information submitted, Ohio EPA concurs with the demonstration.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c), the owner/operator is hereby authorized to continue well MW-6S in the detection monitoring program of the Rumpke Sanitary Landfill as described in OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D). This authorization to continue detection monitoring applies only to the aforementioned sampling event.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water monitoring parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E) or obtain an approval to remain in the detection monitoring program.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the


