Revised Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan Approval

Dear Mr. Migyanko:

On April 12, 1996, Pike Sanitation Landfill was issued a permit to install (PTI # 06-4200) which included an Explosive Gas Monitoring Plan (EGMP). This monitoring plan was properly implemented. On March 22, 2001, Pike Sanitation, Inc. requested to revise the EMGP for the Pike Sanitation Landfill. Ohio EPA received the revised version of the EGMP on October 17, 2002. This revised plan reduces the number of monitoring probes from 54 to 19 and is designed to provide adequate detection monitoring for the facility.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the revised plan and found it to be in compliance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-12, and is hereby approved. Pike Sanitation, Inc. shall install monitoring probes GMP-1, GMP-3, GMP-5, GMP-11, GMP-15, GMP-18, and GMP-30, within thirty (30) days of the approval of this plan.

Issuance of this approval does not constitute expressed or implied agreement that the monitoring of the facility, if performed and implemented in accordance with the approved explosive gas monitoring plan and/or its terms and conditions, will constitute compliance with all applicable state and federal laws, rules and regulations. Issuance of this approval does not relieve Pike Sanitation, Inc. from liability for any past or present violations of the state's environmental laws.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be made in writing and

It must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the Director's action. A copy of the appeal must be served on the Director within three days of filing with the Commission.
