**Re: Bond Road Landfill, Hamilton County  
Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c) Approval**

Dear Mr. Butler,

By correspondence dated May 22, 2003, the owner/operator of Bond Road Landfill located in Hamilton County reported a statistically significant increase for sodium at monitoring well M-2SR3.

A ground water demonstration also dated May 22, 2003, was submitted to the Ohio EPA, indicating that the statistical exceedance noted above was caused by factors other than a release from the landfill. This report was received by Ohio EPA, SWDO on May 23, 2003. Upon review of the information submitted, Ohio EPA does concur with the demonstration that a variation in the ground water quality is not a result of the landfill for monitoring well:

M-2SR3

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c), the owner/operator is hereby authorized to continue the detection monitoring program at Bond Road Landfill for monitoring well M-2SR3, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C) and (D). Upon the effective date of this approval, the owner/operator is not required to comply with OAC 3745-27-10(E) and (F) for the aforementioned sampling event in regard to well M-2SR3.

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water monitoring parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E) or obtain an approval to remain in the detection monitoring program.
