Re: Hoffman Road Landfill Alternate Ground Water Parameter List

Dear Mr. Ruffell:

On August 19, 2002, Hull and Associates, Inc. submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) a request, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(D)(3), for an alternate inorganic ground water monitoring parameter list for the Hoffman Road Landfill (Facility). The facility is located in City of Toledo, Lucas County, Ohio.

The alternate inorganic ground water parameter list for this Facility is hereby approved by Ohio EPA with the following conditions:

1. This approval is for an alternate inorganic ground water monitoring parameter list only for MW-2A and MW-20 monitored by the facility.
2. Boron shall replace sodium and chloride at MW-2A and MW-20 in order to meet the requirements of paragraph (a) and (b) of OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(5), statistical analysis of indicator parameters.
3. The facility will continue to monitor sodium and chloride concentrations at MW-2A and MW-20 in accordance with paragraph (c) of OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(5) at a frequency of semiannual.

Issuance of this alternate ground water monitoring parameter list approval does not constitute expressed or implied agreement that the monitoring of the facility performed and implemented in accordance with the approved ground water monitoring plan and/or its terms and conditions will constitute compliance with applicable State and Federal laws, rules, and regulations, nor does issuance of this plan approval assure that necessary operating permits or licenses will be granted.

You are hereby notified that this action of the director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director of environmental protection within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission. An appeal may be filed with the Environmental Review Appeals Commission at the following address:
