Dear Mr. Butler:

By correspondence dated November 20, 2002, the owner/operator of Bond Road Landfill reported a statistically significant increase in the ammonia concentration in ground water monitoring for well M-16.

A ground water demonstration dated December 5, 2002, was submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO) indicating that the statistically significant increase of ammonia at monitoring well M-16 was caused by factors other than a release from the landfill. The demonstration concluded that the exceedance was attributed to a false positive statistical result due to laboratory variability and not due to a release from the landfill. Upon review of the information submitted, Ohio EPA does concur with the demonstration.

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c), the owner/operator is hereby authorized to continue the detection monitoring program at Bond Road Landfill for monitoring well M-2SR3, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C) and (D).

Should future or existing ground water sampling results indicate statistically significant increases in ground water monitoring parameters, the facility owner/operator will be required to enter into assessment monitoring in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(E) or obtain an approval to remain in the detection monitoring program.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the

action complained of and the ground upon which the appeal is based. The appeal shall be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days after the appeal is filed with the Commission.
