**RE: LICKING COUNTY; SUBURBAN RECYCLING & DISPOSAL FACILITY,
OAC 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c)**

Dear Mr. Palmer:

During April 2004, a ground water sampling event was conducted at the Suburban Recycling & Disposal Facility (RDF). Results from this event indicate that monitoring well MW03A statistically triggered for sodium.

OAC 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c)(ii) requires facilities who have identified statistically significant increases in ground water monitoring parameters to receive approval from the Director in order to remain in detection monitoring. If a facility does not receive approval within 210 days of ground water sampling, the facility is required to initiate their assessment monitoring program.

On June 25, 2004, monitoring well MW03A was resampled for sodium and came back slightly over the statistical control limit, (sample result 11.6 mg/L - limit 11.4 mg/L). Suburban RDF believes that the result is most likely a false positive related to the ground water variability at the site supported by the fact that typical sodium concentrations around the site are 22-70 mg/L; no other indicator parameters are statistically significant and no VOC's were detected at the site.

Ohio EPA concurs with this proposal and as such, this demonstration is hereby approved and Waste Management, Inc. may continue the detection monitoring program in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-27-10(D)(7)(c) at the Suburban Disposal & Recycling Facility for the next ground water sampling event.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. A copy of
