Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) Approval

Dear Mayor Raizk:

On September 27, 2007, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southwest District Office (SWDO) received a document titled "Request to Update Statistical Background for Sodium in Downgradient Monitoring Well P-6S at the Wilmington Sanitary Landfill."

The City has requested approval to update sodium concentrations showing increasing trends. Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g) background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the director.

Ohio EPA, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) has reviewed the proposal and concurs that this data can be added to the background database. It has been determined that sodium concentrations in monitoring well P-6S are attributed to natural variability in the ground water. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-27-10(C)(7)(g), the Facility is authorized to add the sodium data through April 4, 2007 (more than four data points), to the background data set in well P-6S.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC). The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental
