This permit approval is issued subject to the attached conditions which are hereby incorporated and made a part hereof.

PTI SUMMARY

This is a Final Permit to Install (PTI# 06-08186) to increase the authorized maximum daily waste receipt (AMDWR) of the Kimble Sanitary Landfill (Facility), located on 3596 State Route 39 NW, Dover, Ohio south of State Route 39, approximately 3,000 feet west of Township Road 384. This permit authorizes an increase in the Facility's AMDWR from 5,000 tons to 10,000 tons, but Kimble Sanitary Landfill anticipates the average daily waste receipt to be 7,500 tons. The operational life of the landfill would be more than 14.1 years based on the average (expected) gate receipts, or 10.6 years based on the AMDWR. The proposed solid waste disposal area, as authorized in PTI #06-4554 remains unchanged.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the permit approval.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. Issuance of this permit does not relieve Kimble Sanitary Landfill of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
2. The Facility's AMDWR is hereby established to be 10,000 tons. This supersedes any previously established AMDWR for the Facility. This approval shall apply only to the increase in the Facility's AMDWR.
3. The Director, or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above-named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification, or installation of the above-described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal Facility).
4. This permit may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapter 3745-27 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal Facility.
5. The permittee shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the municipal solid waste disposal Facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.

6. Nothing in this permit approval shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This permit approval shall not be interpreted to release Kimble Sanitary Landfill from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
7. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
8. This permit does not authorize the acceptance of any hazardous or infectious wastes, except for those excluded from hazardous waste or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. Unless specifically superseded by this permit, the Facility shall comply with the requirements of all authorizing documents issued prior to this permit.
10. Pursuant to ORC Sections 3745.11(Q) and (V), payment of the solid waste permit-to-install fee balance, in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600) payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio," shall be submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn.: Fiscal Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio, 43216-1049. The fee balance shall be submitted not later than thirty (30) days after the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance paragraphs (Q) and (V) of ORC Section 3745.11
