**RE: TWINSBURG TOWNSHIP LANDFILL, SUMMIT COUNTY
EXPLOSIVE GAS MONITORING PLAN AUTHORIZATION MODIFICATION**

Dear Ms. Gasper, Mr. Balogh, and Mr. Schmidt:

On March 4, 2008, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued a director's letter approving the explosive gas monitoring plan (EGMP) submitted by SCS Engineers on behalf of Twinsburg Township (Twinsburg) in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-27-12, as effective August 15, 2003.

Condition Number 3 of the March 4, 2008, approval states:

“Not later than 60 days after the effective date of this approval, Twinsburg shall implement the EGMP.”

In a letter dated March 18, 2008, Twinsburg requested to modify Condition Number 3 to extend the time to implement the plan due to inclement weather and scheduling issues. The submittal requested, in part, permission to implement the plan no later than 120 days from the March 4, 2008, approval.

Ohio EPA has completed a review of the March 18, 2008, request, and hereby approves the request by modifying Condition Number 3 of the March 4, 2008, approval as follows:

“Not later than 120 days after the effective date of this approval, Twinsburg shall implement the EGMP.”

Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from the requirements of any applicable federal or state laws or regulations. This authorization shall not be interpreted to release Twinsburg or others from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the

Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Toxic Substances Control Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Ohio EPA (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within 30 days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section. An appeal may be filed with the Commission at the following address:
