Dear Ms. Dumontier:

On November 4, 2008, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Solid and Infectious Waste Management (DSIWM), Southwest District Office (SWDO), received a document titled "Statistical Analysis Program for Ground-water Quality Monitoring, Fraser Papers, Inc. Land Reclamation Site" for the Fraser Papers Closed Landfill located in Montgomery County. This document was submitted by Eagon & Associates, Inc. on behalf of Fraser Papers, Inc.

The facility has requested approval to update background on ground water data for wells M-5IAR, M-7IA, M-8IA, and M-8D. Pursuant to Rule 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g), background data can be added only in blocks of data resulting from the analysis of four or more statistically independent samples after the data have been statistically compared to current background data and no statistical differences are detected, unless another method is deemed acceptable to the Director.

Ohio EPA has reviewed the information provided and concurs that this data can be added to the background data group. Therefore, pursuant to OAC Rule 3745-30-08(C)(6)(g), the owner or operator is hereby authorized to update the background database for: sodium concentrations in monitoring well M-5IAR with data from November 2004 to July 2008; sodium concentrations in well M-7IA with data from May 2002 through November 2004; sulfate concentrations in well M-7IA with data from May 2007 through May 2008; chemical oxygen demand (COD) concentrations in wells M-5IAR, M-8IA, and M-8D with data from October 1998 through May 2006, as specified in the revised Statistical Analysis Program – Revision 2, dated November 3, 2008.

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
Ohio EPA does not have enough documentation to support the request to update alkalinity results in well M-7D and well M-71A. This issue will be addressed in a separate correspondence.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection (Director) is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review appeals Commission (Commission) pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
