

## **PERMIT SUMMARY**

This permit-to-install (PTI Number 02-13012) is an authorization to expand the approved limits of solid waste placement previously specified in PTI Number 02-10038 issued on November 6, 1996, at the American Landfill. Specifically, American Landfill, Inc. (applicant) proposes a lateral expansion of the facility.

Limits of waste placement were established in PTI Number 02-5875 for a vertical expansion issued on May 15, 1996. The siting criteria specified in OAC Rule 3745-27-07(H)(4) do not apply to vertical expansion applications. On February 26, 1996, a call-in application was submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA). An unfilled portion of the limits of solid waste placement approved in the May 15, 1996, PTI did not meet the siting criteria specified in OAC Rule 3745-27-07(H)(4)(b) which requires the limits of solid waste placement to be at least 300 feet from the property line. A condition was placed on the call-in PTI prohibiting solid waste placement in this unfilled area. American Landfill, Inc. subsequently has purchased additional property and has demonstrated in this PTI application that the previously approved, unfilled area satisfies the siting criterion contained in OAC Rule 3745-27-07(H)(4)(b). The additional capacity gained through this PTI is 223,762 cubic yards. The currently approved AMDWR is 15,000 tons per day and will remain unchanged.

This summary is provided solely for informational purposes and does not constitute a part of, or otherwise affect, the attached PTI.

## **PERMIT CONDITIONS**

1. The director, or an authorized representative, may enter upon the premises of the above named applicant (permittee) at any reasonable time during construction and operation for the purpose of making inspections, conducting tests, or examining records or reports pertaining to the construction, modification or installation of the above described source of environmental pollutants (municipal solid waste disposal facility).
2. The proposed source shall be constructed in strict accordance with the plans, specifications, and information submitted as part of the application for this permit to the director. There may be no deviation from the approved plans without the express, written approval of Ohio EPA. Any deviation from the approved plans or permit conditions may lead to such sanctions and penalties as provided under Ohio law. Approval of these plans does not constitute an assurance that the proposed facilities will operate in compliance with all Ohio laws and regulations.. Additional facilities shall be installed upon orders of Ohio EPA if the proposed solid waste disposal facility is inadequate or cannot meet applicable standards.

3. issuance of this permit approval does not relieve the applicant of the duty to comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations.
4. This permit approval shall apply only to those facilities shown on the plans submitted as part of PTI application number 02-I 3012, received on April 14, 1999, and as revised on April 22,1999, May 13,1999, November 12,1999, and January 28, 2000.
5. This permit approval may be modified, or alternatively revoked and reissued, to comply with any revisions to OAC Chapters 3745-27 and 3745-31 applicable to this municipal solid waste disposal facility.
6. The owner or operator shall provide for the proper maintenance and operation of the municipal solid waste disposal facility in accordance with the provisions of OAC Chapter 3745-27.
7. Nothing in this permit approval shall be interpreted to release the permit-tee from responsibility under Chapters 3704, 3734, or 6111 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), under the Federal Clean Water or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act or from other applicable laws for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.
8. This permit- approval does not include authorization to accept any hazardous or infectious waste, except for those excluded from hazardous or infectious waste regulation by ORC Chapter 3734.
9. This permit approval does not include authorization to accept any asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material that is subject to the provisions of NESHAP, 40 CFR Part 61, Subpart M. No such asbestos or asbestos-containing waste material may be accepted without first obtaining the necessary permits from Ohio EPA.
- IO. The permittee shall comply with the requirements of PTI Number 02-5875 and detail plans as approved on May 15, 1996, and PTI Number 02-I 0038 and detail plans as approved on November 6,1996. However, any conditions contained herein shall take precedence over any conflicting conditions from previous authorizing documents.

#### **SOLID WASTE PERMIT FEE**

Pursuant to ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V), payment of the solid waste permit-to-install fee balance, in the amount of \$1,837.62 payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio", shall be

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submitted to Ohio EPA, Attn: Fiscal Administration, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1 049. The fee balance shall be submitted within 30 days of the effective date of this permit approval. Failure to timely submit the required permit fee balance will result in assessment of late penalties in accordance with ORC Sections 3745.11 (Q) and (V).
