Permit Alteration to Accept Waste by Rail

Dear Mr. Brady:

On August 21, 2001, you submitted a request to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) to alter PTI Number 03-2980, issued on April 25, 1990, for the Evergreen Recycling and Disposal Facility located in Wood County. The request outlines the installation of a leachate collection and containment system at the rail spur east of cells 10B and 11A, adjacent to the east access road. It is designed to ensure that leachate is properly managed during the acceptance of waste by rail. The previously approved permit only addresses the acceptance of waste by road vehicle.

As proposed, the acceptance of waste by rail is not a substantial change of waste receipt that may endanger human health. Based upon review of the request and supporting documentation, I hereby authorize you to install a leachate collection and containment system in accordance with the design submitted on August 21, 2001, and to accept waste by rail at the facility. This authorization is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Within 90 days after the effective date of this authorization, the owner/operator must have the leachate collection and containment area in place. Once in place, all rail cars on the facility property that contain solid waste must be located within the leachate collection and containment area.
2. Nothing in this letter shall be construed to authorize any waiver from any requirements of applicable state solid waste laws or regulations. This authorization shall not be interpreted to release the owner/operator from responsibility under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapters 3704, 3714, 3734, or 6111; under the Federal Clean Water Act, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Toxic Substances Control Act, or the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and

Liability Act; or from other applicable requirements for remedying conditions resulting from any release of contaminants to the environment.

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director of Environmental Protection is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to ORC Section 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. It must be filed with the commission within 30 days after notice of the director's action. A copy of the appeal must be served on the director within three days of filing with the commission. An appeal may be filed with the commission at the following address:
