

Modeling Guidance  <b>4</b>  <b>Final</b>	<b>Additivity: identifying carcinogens</b>	
	Rule reference: OAC 3745-2-07 (A)	Revision 0, January 30, 1998

For the purpose of the additivity rule, only the carcinogens for which human health criteria or values exist can be considered.

In the Lake Erie drainage basin, carcinogens are identified in Table 33-5 of rule 3745-1-33. Any human health carcinogen criteria developed pursuant to the human health criteria development procedures (OAC 3745-1-38) must also be considered. This information will be provided by Standards and Toxics staff as the criteria are developed.

In the Ohio River drainage basin, carcinogens are not identified in rule, so the criteria development materials on file at Ohio EPA must be consulted. The Standards and Toxics staff should be consulted to determine the status of criteria with respect to carcinogenicity.
