Our qualified pollution prevention (P2) specialists can:

- review your process operations to identify where you can make changes to reduce waste and associated costs
- show you how pollution prevention can help meet your company's sustainability goals
- identify pollution prevention opportunities to include in your environmental management system
- demonstrate how the link between lean manufacturing and pollution prevention can improve your bottom line
- assist you in achieving zero landfill goals by using pollution prevention
- identify innovative ways to use Green Chemistry to improve environmental performance, process efficiency and profitability

Will Ohio EPA's enforcement program know that I called OCAPP?

No. OCAPP is an independent, non-regulatory office within Ohio EPA. Information obtained by the office is not shared with inspection or enforcement staff.

How a P2 assessment works

OCAPP's goal is to provide an onsite assessment that focuses on areas at your company with the greatest potential for waste reduction and cost savings. No confidential or business proprietary information is requested. However, more information allows us to provide more useful recommendations. P2 specialists from OCAPP will then conduct a site visit that typically takes 2 - 4 hours and has three components:

- an opening meeting to review background information
- a facility tour to examine processes and operations; and
- a closing meeting to collect additional information and summarize preliminary P2 opportunities.

Why should I get a P2 assessment?

A second set of eyes on your operations by our P2 specialists may help you uncover additional opportunities to reduce waste and save money.

An Ohio cabinet manufacturer generated large quantities of hazardous and solid waste in the form of used solvents, coatings, sawdust and industrial wastes. After implementing several process changes suggested by OCAPP, they saved more than \$1.5 million and reduced annual emissions by more than 31 million pounds.

The P2 Assessment Report

Within 30 to 90 days after the onsite P2 site visit, OCAPP will send you a draft assessment report. A final report, incorporating any comments, will be sent shortly thereafter.

The report includes recommendations in improving operating practices, material substitutions, process modifications and recycling opportunities. The recommendations may range from simple steps to implement P2 to more substantial modifications.

The report may include estimated economic and environmental benefits to help illustrate potential savings. Case studies and vendor information are provided to support assessment recommendations and make it easier for you to implement the recommendations you choose.

You are not obligated to implement the recommendations in the report. The report is strictly a tool for you to use while evaluating process improvements at your business.
