**Public Notice: Proposed 'No Change' Rulemaking  
Governing Underground Injection Control Rule**

Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Drinking and Ground Waters (DDAGW) is proposing "no change" to rule 3745-34-62 of the Ohio Administrative Code. DDAGW has reviewed this rule to satisfy the five-year rule review requirements of section 106.03 and 106.031 of the Ohio Revised Code. OAC Chapter 3745-34 sets forth the regulations for construction, permitting, maintenance, operations and closure of underground injection wells.
